

To work on conflict prevention, reconciliation and to tackle the roots of conflict and violence....






#### **Assumption of Mother Mary**

These were some of the activities done by our students on this special day


- \* Students of grade I, II and III made tri- coloured flags with pulses.


#### **Onam celebrations**
