INFRASTRUCTURE DETAILS

1. Classrooms

We have well-furnished classrooms (minimum 42 sq. m. each) with a provision of more than 1 sq. m. floor space per student as stipulated in the CBSE Bye-laws. The maximum intake up to class 5 is 30 students and for classes 6 to 8 is 34. This is to ensure that the provision of 1. sq. m. floor space per student is retained. A few classrooms with smart board facilities make teaching and learning joyful and easy.

The total number of classrooms is 24 out of which 16 rooms (15 class divisions from Grade 1 to VIII and one room for Arts and Crafts) are set apart for the academic year 2022-23. The remaining 8 vacant classrooms are meant for the classes 9 and 10 to be sanctioned in the coming years.

2. Library

We have a well-equipped and spacious library with a size of 126.88 Sq.Mtrs having reading and internet facilities. We have sufficient number of age appropriate books which include Fiction, Non-Fiction, Reference Books and Periodicals. We are presently having more than 2800 books and more than 10 periodicals. Guidelines and norms provided by the CBSE Board are strictly followed in the selection of books and other reading materials. The service of a qualified librarian is available in the school. Library books are issued regularly. "Reading maketh a full man; Conference a ready man; and writing an exact man"

3. Composite Science Laboratory

A well-equipped composite science lab measuring a size of 126.88 sq.mtrs is available in the school to cater to the needs of students from Grade 1 to Grade 10. Students are able to make the learning more interesting, and fundamental concepts in science are made more clear and vivid through experiments and experiential learning.

4. Computer Laboratory

A computer lab with a size of 63.70 sq.mtrs is well equipped with 41 computers and maintains computer to student ratio of 1:20 as stipulated in the Affiliation Bye-Laws. The computers have internet connectivity and good speed. The service of a qualified teacher is made available to see that every student is cared for cyber safety.

5. Mathematics Laboratory

The school has made available a separate room for a Mathematics lab (52.53sq.mtrs) with necessary mathematical equipment. It makes learning more effective, enjoyable and interesting.

6. Dance and Music Room

One room with a size of 52.53 sq. m is set apart for dance and music. Much effort is made by the school to develop the potential talents in the field of music and dance. Singing or dancing is an act of creation.

7. Arts and Crafts Room

A room with the size of 42 sq. m. is set apart for arts and crafts. It is said that 'Art is the Science of Creativity'. All students have to become more creative in their ideas, perception and thinking. Students are given training in painting, sculpture and carving etc. This is meant for holistic and sustainable development of the students.

8. Counselling Room

We aim at a 'healthy and happy life' for all students enrolled in our school. An Action Plan is, therefore, prepared under the leadership of a qualified Counsellor. This is to enrich life skills, holistic health and wellbeing, favourable

attitudes and habits and the elimination of undesirable traits among students. A separate room is set apart for conducting counselling for students.

9. Sports Room

Upholding the dictum that 'healthy mind in a healthy body' we have introduced facilities for sports, games and athletics among which football, basketball, shuttle, badminton, volley ball, throw ball, etc. occupy a greater role in keeping students physically healthy and fit. Medical check-up is regularly held. 200 metre athletic track facilities are also available in our spacious playground. A separate room with a size of 36 sq. m. is made available for sports activities.

10. Drinking water, Toilet and other Physical facilities

- There is provision for adequate facilities for portable drinking water on each floor.
- Facilities for clean, healthy and hygienic toilets on each floor with washing facilities for boys and girls separately.
- Special toilets for the disabled are arranged
- Special toilets with washing facilities for the staff are available.
- Signage boards are displayed on the toilets of all categories
- Ramps at the entry and exit points for wheel chair usage are provided.
- Suitable furniture in the class rooms commensurate with the strength of the students.
- Required equipment and facilities for science, maths, computer subjects and activities under work experience and art education.
- Guidelines related to the safety of the children in schools issued by
 - a) The Honourable Supreme Court of India
 - b) School Safety Policy 2016
 - c) Manual on Safety and Security of Children in Schools
 - d) National Building Code 2005 as amended from time to time
- Prescription from the State Government/ Panchayat Authority/ Transport Department/Department of Fire and Rescue Services regarding Health & Hygiene, Drinking water, Fire Safety, Building Safety and Transport precautions are scrupulously observed.
- Adequate facilities for recreation activities, social, cultural, moral and spiritual development of students
- Adequate spacious ground for outdoor facilities like football, basketball, volley ball, throw ball, 200 m athletics rack etc.
- Availability of 1 sq. m. Built - Up Floor Area per child in the class room is ensured.

- Enrolment of students and number of sections is done as per the availability of land and infrastructure as given in Appendix V of CBSE Bye - Laws.
