**Important Notes :** 1. The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 22 as per the number of sections reported during inspection and number of the school students shall be restricted to 32 in 12 sections (as dimension of the some classrooms are in between 400 to 500 sq ft.) . Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law .  
 2. As stated by school before the review committee, work of the installation of lift to access upper floors is under construction. Further, there are two building blocks with multiple floors. Therefore, the school is directed to construct the ramp/lift to access upper all the floors and separate CWSN toilets for girls and boys

on each floors with proper permanent signage, indicating the floor number in both the building block as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines ( [https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05\\_2023.pdf](https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf) ) within 03 months and submit the compliance.

3. There is construction material lying in the school premises and work of levelling the ground is under process. Thus, the school is directed to complete the same with adequate outdoor game facilities within 03 months and submit the compliance.

4. The school is required to make the separate reading space for the staff in the library and make the gas fittings in the composite science lab with the desired norms and standards within 03 months and submit the compliance.

5. Failure to submit compliance for the above mentioned piunts within prescribed time shall invite financial penalty against the school.

6. The school shall follow the SoPs issued by the Board in respect of labs, library and sports facilities.

7. The school shall not remove the videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website and renew all mandatory certificates from time to time

8. The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Trivandrum within 3 months and submit the compliance.
